

What To Do After a Car Accident Checklist

1 Move to a Safer Area

2 Check for Injuries

3 Call the Police

4 Exchange Information with Other Driver

Exchange the following info with the other driver(s):

- Name
- Home Address
- Phone Number
- Insurance Company
- Insurance Policy Number
- Driver's License Number

5 Gather Witness Info

Get the following info from any witnesses:

- Name
- Phone Number
- What did they see?
- When is a good time to contact them?

6 Document Evidence

Taking photographs of:

- Both cars from numerous angles
- All damage to both cars
- Other car's license plate
- Place where the accident occurred, including road, signs, etc.
- Additional factors, like debris roadway, broken street light, etc.

Get the police officer's:

- Name
- Badge number

Get a Copy of the Accident Report, if possible

7 Seek Medical Attention Right Away

Seek medical attention right away. If you do not need an ambulance, be sure to get medical attention at a hospital or primary care physician as soon as possible. Any delay could be used against you later.

8 Keep a File of All Documents and Info

The most commonly used file sections are:

- Correspondence
- Medical Bills
- Medical Records
- Property Damage
- Wage Verification
- Reports and Witnesses
- Photographs
- Notes
