- Move to a Safer Area
- 2 Check for Injuries
- Call the Police
- Exchange Information with Other Driver

Exchange the following info with the other driver(s):

- Name
- Home Address
- Phone Number
- Insurance Company
- Insurance Policy Number
- Driver's License Number
- Gather Witness Info

Get the following info from any witnesses:

- Name
- Phone Number
- What did they see?
- When is a good time to contact them?
- 6 Document Evidence

Taking photographs of:

- Both cars from numerous angles
- All damage to both cars
- Other car's license plate
- Place where the accident occurred, including road, signs, etc.
- Additional factors, like debris roadway, broken street light, etc.

Get the police officer's:

- Name
- Badge number

Get a Copy of the Accident Report, if possible

Seek Medical Attention Right Away

Seek medical attention right away. If you do not need an ambulance, be sure to get medical attention at a hospital or primary care physician as soon as possible. Any delay could be used against you later.
